There are plans to enhance the health finance materials. However, due to the disruptions associated with the pandemic, these changes are taking longer than expected.

However, as a result of the covid 19 pandemic, the HCA program has modified the internship requirement on a temporary basis. Students have the option to do a thesis instead of internship on site. There is no preceptor in the modified intership class, so this cannot be evaluated for AY 2019-2020. At least 90% of the students will receive a high performance rating (80% or above) on the preceptor evaluations of their internship related to providing written reports/paper/project and other assignment demonstrating their ability to utilize effective communication methods when interacting with clinicians, technicians, and administrative individuals as well as with employees with diverse backgrounds.
