Estimated program cost of \$4,000* includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from Louisville
- Room accommodations in all locations
- An average of two meals per day while in Costa Rica
- Admission for all activities listed in the itinerary
- Basic international health insurance
- Travel by chartered motor coach throughout the trip
- Tuition for (3 hrs) of Honors BIOL 285: Costa Rican Biodiversity
- All WKU Study Abroad and Global Learning student fees

*If, for example, the actual program cost is \$4,000, students who have never used their one-time \$1,000 Gatton Academy Study Abroad Scholarship will only pay \$3,000.

Selected students will pay the program and application fees via TopNet or to the *WKU Bursar's Office, Potter Hall 2nd floor* by a to-be-determined billing deadline in the second half of the fall semester. **After November 1st, any student selected for the program who forfeits their spot will be financially responsible for the cost of the program, unless another student is able to take their spot.**

Application Process:

- All applications must be submitted in The Gatton Academy office to Ms. Melanie Redden (FSH 107) by September 19th at 3:30pm Central.
- Please submit a copy of the student's passport ID page via email to gatton.academics@wku.edu (if they already have a passport).
- No payments are due or accepted at the time of application
- Spots are limited to 32 students. Typically, half of the spots are saved for each class, 2026 and 2027. Shortly after the application deadline, applicants will be divided into four categories: North side Seniors, North side Juniors, South side Seniors, and South side Juniors. Those who have not traveled abroad with The Gatton Academy previously are given first priority for selection using a random lottery. Once students have been selected from each category, random drawing continues until all students have been drawn to form an ordered waitlist for any program spot that might become available later. All students will be notified of their selection by October 3rd.
- After students are notified of acceptance, students and parents will need to complete additional forms for the WKU Study Abroad and Global Learning office.
