The Social Work major prepares students to advocate for and provide support to individuals and communities facing personal, social, and economic challenges. Students learn about human behavior, social welfare policies, counseling techniques, and case management, equipping them to work in diverse environments. Graduates typically pursue careers in healthcare, mental health, child welfare, and community organizations, where they help clients navigate life challenges, access resources, and improve their well-being. Typical industry sectors include social services, government agencies, healthcare, non-profit organizations, and education.
