- E. Eligibility requires having completed ENG 516 and having taught two sections of WKU ENG 100/100E or the equivalent course at another institution.
- F. A complete application will include a current CV, a tentative ENG 200 syllabus, a PDF with the two responses, and this completed PDF application in your email submission.
