CRD Roof Sections 20,25,28

- Issue Addressed: Existing roof had developed a series of leaks and failed insulation across a broad expanse. The failed areas were cut out and repaired, overlayed with an additional R-9, and a new membrane applied. 15-year warranty purchased. This was a conditionbased renewal.
- Funding Source: AP-312,770.89

- Issue addressed: Over time this elevator had become obsolete.

- Issue addressed: Existing lighting has aged to a point that parts were becoming problematic/expensive. Several common areas were converted to LED to restore failed lighting to operation and ability to harvest good parts for reutilization elsewhere.
