

Method: Insource (AT4)




Completed Project - Stadium Walls

What: Concrete repairs and coating at HILTS (W) and the berm.

Issue Addressed: the horizontal surface as the berm and on the west side of the stadium, have over time, spalled. A total of 17 stalls were repaired and the entire wall cap was coated to prevent future water intrustion. This was a condition based renewal.


