Required Documents:

1. Baccalauréat and High School/Secondary transcripts

OR

Cameroon General Certificate of Education-Ordinary Level along with Secondary transcripts

- 2. Proof of English Proficiency. WKU accepts the following documents:
 - TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, DuoLingo, PTE
- 3. If you are applying as an undergraduate transfer student from another university, you will also need to submit your university transcripts

<u>First Time Freshman</u>: Applicants must have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale) in academic subjects at the secondary level

<u>Transfer Students</u>: To be admitted in good standing, applicants must have GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) and be in good standing with your previous/current university.
