

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UNDERGRADUATE

- English translation of transcripts (equivalent to US high school or college)
- First year: 2.5 GPA or Transfer: 2.0 GPA
- Proof of English proficiency or English language of instruction
 - TOEFL 71, IELTS 6.0, or Duolingo 100
- IPAS requirements: 2.25 GPA with TOEFL 61, IELTS 5.5 or Duolingo 90

GRADUATE

- Official transcripts and a certified English translation demonstrating completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Adequate academic preparation in the field of specialization
- Any additional program requirements (writing samples, resume/vita, GRE/GMAT scores, etc.)
- Proof of English proficiency or English language of instruction
 - TOEFL, IBT – 79, IELTS – 6.5 or ELS - Level 112

All documents, including financial proof, and the application fee of \$75 must be received before an admission decision can be made.
