

Pre-Arrival Checklist

You should have received your official acceptance letter and I-20 or DS-2019 from WKU. If you have not, please contact our admissions staff at applyinternational@wku.edu.

WKU does not require immunizations or proof of vaccination for admittance. Some majors/programs require immunizations. Consult with your department for program information.

- Pay SEVIS I-901 fee: Department of Homeland Security Form I-901
- Obtain an F-1 or J-1 student visa at your local US Embassy or Consulate General
- Confirm your arrival with WKU via the form here: Confirmation of Attendance Form
- All students must complete our online orientation through Blackboard. You will receive an email with completion information.
 - o Students must complete the online orientation before course registration is permitted.
 - More information on the next steps will be emailed to you after completion of orientation through Blackboard.
 - o **J-1 Exchange students:** our office will make contact about course scheduling.

 - o WKU tuition and expenses information.
