Undergraduate Admission Requirements for Students Educated in

Senegal

Required Documents:

1. *Baccalauréat/Baccalauréat Technique*: Completion certificate and transcript of high school grades (an English translated copy must be submitted as well)
2. Proof of English Proficiency. WKU accepts the following documents:
 - TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, DuoLingo, PTE
3. If you are applying as an undergraduate transfer student from another university, you will also need to submit your university transcripts

Grading Scale Conversion for Senegal:

Minimum Academic Requirements:

First Time Freshman: Applicants must have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale) in academic subjects at the secondary level

Transfer Students: To be admitted in good standing, applicants must have GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) and be in good standing with your previous/current university.
