Charles “Charley” L. Pride, director of student activities at Western Kentucky University, was recently appointed to the board of trustees for the Omicron Delta Kappa Society and Educational Foundation Inc.

His three-year term as one of the society’s faculty/staff trustees will begin July 1.

In the 2024-25 fiscal and academic year, Pride will also serve as chair-elect of the society’s Mission Committee.

Pride is a 2001 initiate of the Western Kentucky University Circle (chapter) of Omicron Delta Kappa and has worked as an adviser for the Western Kentucky University circle for the last several years. His experience in student affairs began with his B.A.,

M.A. and Ed.S. from Western Kentucky University. He later earned his Ph.D. in educational administration from the University of Louisville.

Pride serves as the director of Student Activities at WKU, overseeing registered student organizations, SGA, Greek life, leadership and volunteerism, and the student union.
