The President's ONE WKU Award recognizes and rewards a Western Kentucky University student, staff, and faculty member for exemplary leadership and achievement in fostering a welcoming, collaborative, and supportive environment at WKU and within the communities it serves. This award encourages creativity, dialogue, and action through advocacy, role modeling, scholarship, and/or service.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nominees must be full-time faculty, full-time staff, or full-time enrolled students at WKU, with awards presented in each of these three categories.

For consideration, nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Has actively participated in initiatives that cultivate a sense of belonging, engagement, and mutual respect at Western Kentucky University and/or the communities it serves.
- Has demonstrated a commitment to ensuring all individuals are valued and treated with dignity and respect.
- Has contributed efforts beyond the scope of their job title and responsibilities, with an impact extending beyond their formal position.
- Has engaged in initiatives that foster collaboration, access to opportunities, and meaningful engagement across various arenas.
- Has made a unique contribution addressing key issues related to creating and welcoming and supportive campus and community environment.
