PHILANTHROPIC NAMING REQUEST FOR TINCHER FOUNDATION

REQUEST:

Approval of the philanthropic naming of a residence hall to be determined in recognition of a generous gift from the Robert and Mary Tincher Charitable Foundation Inc.

FACTS:

The Robert and Mary Tincher Charitable Foundation Inc. is a private foundation in Bowling Green, Ky., established by Robert and Mary Tincher, who graduated from WKU in 1952 and 1949, respectively.

Robert Tincher, a World War II veteran, was originally from Beattyville, Ky., and he was a basketball player for legendary Coach Ed Diddle while at WKU. Robert Tincher was CEO of Monarch Environmentals, Inc., in Bowling Green for 25 years. Mary Tincher, who was originally from Fulton, Ky., worked for many years at both Western Kentucky Gas Co. and Bowling Green Parks & Recreation. Robert Tincher passed away in 2009, and Mary Tincher passed in 2018.

The Tinchers and the Robert and Mary Tincher Charitable Foundation Inc. are longtime donors of WKU. They have provided support for areas including scholarships, the Hilltopper Athletic Foundation and the Chandler Memorial Chapel.

Tincher Hall is named in recognition of the generous philanthropic support of WKU by the Robert and Mary Tincher Charitable Foundation Inc.
