Program Notes

The BSW program requires a separate application, in addition to the WKU application for admission to the University. To be eligible for admission, you must complete have successfully completed the required prerequisites and have a minimum 2.5 GPA. If you plan to start the WKU BSW Program in the fall (can be completed in 4 semesters), you must submit your program application on or before April 1st. If you plan to start the WKU BSW Program in the Spring (can be completed in 5 semesters), you must submit your program application on or before November 1st.

The following courses are prerequisites for admission to the BSW program with a "C" in each: ENG 101, PSY 110 or PSY 223, SOC 101, HMS 102 & a required elective DEI course.
