The following courses are prerequisites for admission to the BSW program: ENG 101, PSY 110 or PSY 223, SOC 101, POL 101, BIO 112/113, ECO 101 or ECO 201 or ECO 202, HMS 102 or SWK 124, STA 220. You must have a GPA of 2.5 for admission to program.
