Spring 2026 FUSE Grant: Fuel Your Research Journey

The FUSE Grant empowers your research with up to \$3,000 for project expenses, a \$500 stipend for successful completion, and, for global projects, the International FUSE Award adds up to \$1,000 for international activities. Applications open in Fall 2025 (due by October 31, 2025), with funds available starting January 15, 2026, and final reports due May 15, 2027. Here's a guide to help students and mentors navigate the spending rules.

What Can You Spend the FUSE Grant On?

Starting January 15, 2026 (no pre-award spending allowed), the \$3,000 grant covers:

- Project-related expenses: Supplies, equipment, or travel needed for your research.
- Conference travel: Costs for you to present your work at a conference.
- Mentor travel: Support for your faculty mentor to join you at the conference.
- Tuition scholarship: Covers tuition for the one-hour FUSE course if it increases your tuition.

Key Rule: Funds can only support the student(s) named in the FUSE application.

International FUSE Award

Going global? The International FUSE Award includes the standard \$3,000 award plus up to \$1,000 for international research activities.

\$500 Completion Stipend

Successfully complete your project and submit your final report by May 15, 2027, to earn a \$500 stipend (split equally if multiple students are involved).

Spending Rules & Responsibilities

Your faculty mentor manages and monitors funds, ensuring compliance with university and departmental policies. Here's the breakdown:

- Expenses: Charged to your mentor's departmental index or purchasing card (Pcard), then
 reimbursed from the FUSE grant index after FUSE index approval by the Office of Research
 and Creative Activity (ORCA).
- No out-of-pocket reimbursement: Personal expenses (except specific travel costs like per diem or mileage) cannot be reimbursed.

How to Spend FUSE Funds

Include your FUSE award number (26-SPXXX), student name, and mentor name on all requests.

Travel

Follow WKU travel policies (contact the Travel Office at (270) 745-5327 for details), and choose the least expensive travel options:

- Up-front costs (i.e. airfare, lodging): Use your mentor's departmental Pcard. Once charges appear in JP Morgan Chase, department staff can email fuse@wku.edu (subject: "HARDCODES") to transfer charges to the FUSE index.
- Out-of-pocket travel costs (e.g., food, mileage, taxi fare): **Reimbursed after travel via a Travel Voucher**. After departmental approval, email the voucher to fuse@wku.edu for FUSE index approval. You can find more information on travel guidelines here.

Materials & Supplies

- Order using your mentor's departmental Pcard. Once charges appear online (i.e. JPMC), departmental staff (Office Associate/Coordinator) can email <u>fuse@wku.edu</u> with the invoice/receipt and a screenshot of the charge to transfer to the FUSE index.
- Tax-exempt: Use WKU's tax-exempt number (on the Pcard) to avoid taxes.
- Ownership: Supplies become departmental property after the award ends.
- No personal cards: Purchases on personal credit cards may not be reimbursed.
- Deadline: Complete all Pcard and purchase orders 30 days before the award's end date.

Paying Personnel/Human Subjects

Follow WKU's standard procedures for paying personnel or human subject participants through the Office of Research Integrity's compliance program on human subjects research. Submit all forms to the Office or Research Integrity (ORI), located in the Wetherby Administration Building, Room 301, or email ori@wku.edu, for approval by ORI's authorized representative.

- Application Portal Opens: September 4, 2025
- Application Deadline: October 31, 2025 for students with Mentor Approval by November 6th
- Award Start Date: January 15, 2026
- Final Report Due: May 15, 2027
