It is therefore recommended that some graded evaluation for freshmen be accomplished by the end of the first five (5) weeks of the fall and spring semesters to assist faculty with this assessment.

5th Week Check-In is an early alert system for all students enrolled in 100-level, 200-level, and writing in the discipline courses at WKU. During the 5th Week of the semester, faculty teaching these courses enter grades (either Passing or D/F) and attendance. Students can view their official reports on TopNet. Students are encouraged to check in after their report is ready with their advisors, instructors, and residence life staff regarding academics, finances, and any other concerns. Faculty and staff can track their follow-up conversations regarding 5th Week in TopNet.
