Program Notes

HMS 102 or SWK 124 course must be taught by an instructor with a Master of Social Work degree.

*These classes are required prerequisites for admission into the WKU BSW program. Completion of all 5 prerequisites, in addition to a 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA, is required for BSW admission.

**These classes are additional courses required for the BSW program that may be taken within KCTCS or after admission to WKU but must be completed prior to graduation from the WKU BSW program.

The WKU BSW Program requires a separate (free) application from the WKU application. The BSW Application for FALL START is due April 1st. It is recommended that all prerequisites be completed by winter break of the semester before the application is made to ensure the application can be fully processed. If a student is completing one of more prerequisites in the spring semester and is not finished by the April 1st application deadline, the application will be deferred until the student verifies that all prerequisites are completed. With FALL admission, the program can be completed in 4 semesters.

The application deadline for **SPRING START is November 1**st. If you start the **WKU BSW Program in SPRING**, the program can be completed in 5 semesters.
